Study Centre Programme & Fees

Courses are structured to the needs of the individual student. Students preparing for entry to UK Boarding school programmes study according to the requirements of the year of entry. All courses include a minimum of 20 hours English lessons per week.

In addition, academic lessons in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Economics, Business Studies, Accounting and Art can be included according to individual requirements.

Students wishing to enter Sixth form at 16/17 years – A level or IB courses – will, in addition to English, study the background relating to their chosen subjects. If appropriate they will complete an intensive IGCSE course in their subjects and be entered for these examinations.

Students who have previously completed all or the majority of their secondary education will have the opportunity to study their chosen subjects to A level standard on intensive study programmes. Those wishing to include a science subject at this level may be required to pay a supplementary fee to cover the practical elements required.

Examinations at GCSE, IGCSE, AS/A2 and Pre-U level can be taken. In addition, students study appropriate courses in order to sit the Cambridge IELTS, FCE, CAE and CPE examinations. All examination fees and any associated transport costs are charged in addition to course fees.

Course fees include all tuition costs and academic materials according to the designed programme ; full board host family accommodation ; laundry costs ; any trips and excursions relating to the course; initial collection from London Heathrow Airport.
